

## ORDINANCE NO. 720

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 715 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREFORE.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 15-320 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, KANSAS, AND THE REPEAL OF SECTION 15-320.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 15-320 is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 2. RATES.** The following rates will apply according to the various classifications for usage of electric current.

(a) City Residential - Lighting and General Appliance Service.

Availability: All territory served by the city for electric service supplied to one customer through one metering point, and to be used exclusively for domestic purposes. Service is for exclusive use of customer, and is not to be resold or shared with others. Where two or more dwelling units such as duplexes, apartments, and trailer homes, each having separate kitchen facilities, are served through one meter, Schedule R-75 may be applied by multiplying the KWH blocks by the number of dwelling units served or at the option of the city, Schedule CSP-75 will be applied. Where more than four rooms in a residence are rented, or are available for rent, such residence shall be considered as a commercial rooming house, and billed on Schedule CSP-75. Residential Schedule R-75 is not available to residential premises used for commercial purposes; however, if the customer's wiring is so arranged that electric service for domestic and non-domestic purposes can be metered separately, then Schedule R-75 applies to that portion used for domestic purposes.

Character of Service: Alternating current, single phase, approximately 60 cycles, and at voltage the city has available for service required.

Customer Charge: \$3.50 per month, no consumption. In the event the same customer orders a disconnection or reconnection of electric service at the same premises within a period of 12 months, the city shall collect as a reconnection charge, the sum of such customer charge as would have accrued during the period of disconnection.

Monthly Rates:

12.075¢ per KWH for the first 200 KWH

8.625¢ per KWH for all over 200 KWH

(b) Commercial and Small Power Service, Schedule CSP-75

Availability: All territory served by the city for electric service supplied to one customer conducting a gainful enterprise through one meter, and whose usage is less than 150,000 KWH per year. Service is for exclusive use of customer, and is not to be resold or shared with others.

Character of Service: Alternating current, approximately 60 cycles, single phase or three phase 120/240 volts, 4-wire delta, 120/208 volts, 4-wire wye, 240 volts, 3-wire delta, or at the voltage and phase the city has available for service required.

Capacity Charge: \$2 per KW per month.

Monthly Rates:

13.225¢ per KWH first 200 KWH

10.64¢ per KWH for the next 1000 KWH

9.49¢ per KWH for all over 1,000 KWH

Minimum Charge: \$5.52 per month, for which customer may use 50 KWH, or \$1 per connected meter horsepower, whichever is greater. If a customer's monthly consumption is 200 KWh or less, no capacity charge will be assessed, but a customer charge of \$3.50 will be assessed. If consumption is over 200 KWh monthly, for 4 consecutive months during the year, a capacity charge of \$2.00 per KW per month will be assessed, until such time as the monthly consumption is 200KWh or less for 12 consecutive months. In the event the same customer orders a disconnection or reconnection of electric service at the same premises within a period of 12 months, the city shall collect as a reconnection charge the sum of such minimum bills as would have accrued during period of disconnection.

(c) Power, Schedule P-75

Availability: All territory served by the city for electric service supplied to one customer whose usage is more than 150,000 KWH per year. Service is for exclusive use of customer, and is not to be resold or shared with others.

Character of Service: Alternating current, approximately 60 cycles, single phase or three phase, 120/240 volts, 4-wire delta, 120-208 volts, 4-wire wye, 240 volts, 3-wire delta, or at the voltage and phase the city has available for service required.

Capacity Charge: \$3 per KW per month.

Monthly Rate: 8.05¢ per KWh for all energy used per month.


Minimum Charge:


(1) \$1 per month per connected horsepower. In the event the customer orders a disconnection and reconnection of electric service at the same premises within a period of 12 months, the city may collect as a reconnection charge the sum of such minimum bills as would have accrued during period of disconnection.

- (2) Where it is necessary to make unusual extension or to reinforce distribution lines to provide service such that in the judgment of the city the revenue to be derived from or the duration of the prospective business is not sufficient under the above stated minimum bill calculated upon reasonable considerations before undertaking to supply the service. In such cases, the consumer may be required to enter into a written contract with the city as to the character, amount and duration of the service offered.


**SECTION 3.** That Section 15-320 of the Code of the City of Mankato is hereby repealed, and this ordinance is substituted therefore.
