

ORDINANCE NO. 727

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 716, AND AMENDING THE RATES FOR WATER IN CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 15-225 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 15-225 "Rates" is hereby amended as follows:

RATES.

(a) That the rates for water used within the city limits shall be:

Minimum monthly rate for first 300 cubic feet = \$26.50
301 to 1,599 cubic feet = \$3.90 per 100 cu. ft.
1,600 to 5,099 cubic feet = \$3.37 per 100 cu. ft.
5,100 and over = \$3.09 per 100 cu. ft.

(b) The residential rural rates for water, metered by the City, shall be at the same rate as that for residential customers plus \$7.60 per month.

(c) The commercial or industrial rates, outside the city limits, for water metered by the City shall be:

First 400 cu. ft. with meter size up to and including 2" = \$32.07
First 400 cu. ft. with meter size of 3" = \$38.54
First 400 cu. ft. with meter size of 4" = \$55.30
First 400 cu. ft. with meter size of 6" = \$85.57
First 400 cu. ft. with meter size of 8" or larger = \$135.84
Next 2,600 cu. ft. = \$3.41 per 100 cu ft
Next 97,000 cu. ft. = \$3.10 per 100 cu ft
All over 100,000 cu. ft. = \$2.09 per 100 cu ft

SECTION 2. That Ordinance 716, and Section 15-225, Article 2, Chapter 15 of the 1992 Code of the City of Mankato, is hereby repealed, and this ordinance is substituted therefore.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper and shall apply to water usage beginning in September, 2020.

ORDINANCE NO. 726

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 711 AND AMENDING CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 4, SECTION 431 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 15, Article 4, Section 431 of the Code of the City of Mankato, Kansas, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. RATES. The sewage service charges for each month or fractional month shall be as follows:

Inside the City Limits:


- (a) ✓ Residential - \$18.00
- (b) ✓ Laundries, Services Stations, and Cafes - \$37.44
- (c) ✓ Schools - \$1.00 per student
- (d) ✓ Hospitals and rest homes - \$3.00 per bed
- (e) ✓ Motels and Hotels - \$3.00 per unit
- (f) ✓ All businesses and professional offices not listed above \$23.92


Outside the City Limits:

- (g) ✓ Residential - \$25.29
- (h) Laundries, Service Stations & Cafes - \$53.66
- (i) Schools - \$1.41 per student
- (j) Hospitals & Rest Homes - \$9.03 per bed
- (k) ✓ Motels and Hotels - \$9.03 per unit
- (l) ✓ All businesses and professional offices not listed above \$33.38

SECTION 3. That Chapter 15, Article 4, Section 431 of the Code of the City of Mankato, Kansas, is hereby amended.


